About Leadership Pendleton

Leadership Pendleton is a program designed for citizens in the Pendleton community who want to develop their personal leadership skills and become better informed about the assets of their community. This leadership training is sponsored by the Town of Pendleton and developed by the Leadership Pendleton Board of Regents. In addition, the Leadership Pendleton Alumni Association supports the program.

The 2011 program will begin on Saturday, February 12, and conclude on Monday, April 25. The program consists of twelve (12) sessions on consecutive Tuesday nights from 6:00p—8:30p, with one (1) Saturday session, and a Wednesday day trip to Columbia to sit in on a State legislative session. Program sessions will address such topics as personal leadership skills, history, economic development, arts and culture, festivals, education, state and local government, waste treatment, recycling, health and human services, and public safety.

A graduation ceremony sponsored by the Leadership Pendleton Alumni Association concludes the course work on April 25.
