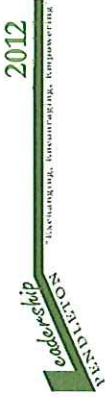
## About Leadership Pendleton

Leadership Pendleton is a program designed for citizens in the Pendleton community who want to develop their personal leadership skills and become better informed about the assets of their community. This leadership training is sponsored by the Town of Pendleton and developed by the Leadership Pendleton Board of Regents. In addition, the Pendleton Leadership Foundation supports the program.

The 2012 program will begin on Saturday, February 18, and conclude on Monday, April 30. The program consists of nine (9) sessions on Tuesday nights from 6:00p—8:30p, with two (2) Saturday sessions, and a Wednesday day trip to Columbia to sit in on a State legislative session. Program sessions will address such topics as personal leadership skills, history, economic development, arts and culture, education, state and local government, wastewater, public safety, health and tourism.

A graduation ceremony sponsored by the Pendleton Leadership Foundation concludes the course work on April 30.
