

**PENDLETON TOWN COUNCIL
REGULAR SESSION
JANUARY 3, 2011
7:00 PM**

MINUTES:

After due notice to the press, Mayor and Town Council met in the Council Chambers of Town Hall. Mayor and all Council were present.

1) PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE LED BY THE PENDLETON ELKS LODGE:

Sandra Gantt, representing the Elks Lodge, led the Pledge of Allegiance.

2) COUNCIL UPDATES:

Mayor Hayes stated ACSO would not be present this evening. Bruce Kalley made a motion to delete item 6 from the agenda. Frank Crenshaw seconded. Unanimous.

Mayor Hayes gave the following updates:

~December 9th, the State of Pendleton Address was sponsored by the Clemson Area Chamber and held at Tri-County Technical College. He stated his speech is available online as well as hard copies available at Town Hall.

~December 12th, the Christmas Parade was held and thanked Kandice Morgan and the entire Public Works Department as well as all participants for a great parade.

~Dr Hellams, a long time resident, fell last week and broke his shoulder. Everyone was asked to keep him in their thoughts and prayers.

Mayor Hayes gave a brief overview of agenda items.

4) APPROVAL OF MINUTES

6) ANDERSON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE REPORT:

7) ADMINISTRATOR'S UPDATE AND BUDGET REPORT:

Amber Barnes updated Mayor, Council and citizens for the month of December.

8) PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT REPORT:

Phil Harris, Public Works Director, updated Mayor, Council and citizens for the past quarter. He stated Travis Wood was hired to fill a vacancy and feels he will be an asset to the town.

9) PENDLETON/CLEMSON WASTE TREATMENT FACILITY UPDATE:

Doris Wilson, Chief Operator, updated Mayor, Council and citizens for the past quarter. She stated the upgrade is on schedule and DHEC will be onsite Wednesday to approve the upgrade thus far. It was further stated that on January 1st, she received the new permit for the Waste Treatment Facility. 209.4 million gallons were treated in 2010.

10) APPOINTMENT TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION TO FILL JIM SMITHS TERM: JANUARY 1, 2011 – DECEMBER 31, 2014:

Frank Crenshaw made a motion to postpone this item for another month to see if someone from Ward 3 shows interest since that Ward is not represented on the Planning Commission. Bruce Kalley seconded. Unanimous.

11) SECOND AND FINAL READING OF "AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE TOWN OF PENDLETON'S SEWER USE ORDINANCE":

Sandra Gantt made a motion to accept the above Ordinance for second and final reading. Denise Jackson seconded. Unanimous.

There being no further business, Frank Crenshaw made a motion to adjourn. Bruce Kalley seconded. Unanimous. The meeting adjourned at 7:35 pm.
