MINUTES:

1) SPECIAL PRESENTATIONS:

a. FALL FESTIVAL COMMITTEE:

Mayor Burdette presented Jean Vegod, Fall Festival Committee Chair, as well as several Sub-Committee Chairs, with a certificate for all their work organizing the Fall Festival.

b. FIRE DEPARTMENT DONATION:

Mayor Burdette presented Bobby Pruitt, Fire Chief, with a check in the amount of \$1,000. Mayor Burdette donated her budgeted 2009/2010 contingency fund to the Fire Department.

c. CHRISTI FRICKS:

Mayor Burdette presented Christi Fricks with a Proclamation, proclaiming November 2, 2009, as Christi Fricks Day in the Town of Pendleton. Christi was awarded the 2008 Presidential Award for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching.
