**MINUTES:**

After due notice to the press, Mayor and Town Council met in the Council Chambers of Town Hall. Mayor and all Council were present.

Mayor Hayes made a request to add Discussion of Town of Pendleton Administrator to the Agenda. Frank Crenshaw made a motion to grant the request to add the above item to the agenda. Denise Jackson seconded. Unanimous.

**1) PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:**

Sandra Gantt led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**2) COUNCIL UPDATES:**

***Mayor Hayes gave the following updates:***

~On Wednesday, November 9, 2011, the National Emergency Alert System test will be conducted at 2 pm for approximately 3 ½ minutes.

~ There have been several reported sightings of wild animals in town. Please report any and all sightings to Animal Control at 646-9073.

~On October 15, 2011, the annual Maintenance Day of Barrett's Place Playground took place. A debt of gratitude goes out to the many volunteers who participated.

~ On November 2, 2011, Town Hall hosted two second grade classes from La France Elementary to discuss Town Government and Elected Officials.

~On November 3-5, 2011, the Your Town Project, a collaborative effort between Clemson University and the Town, concluded a three day workshop. A special thanks to Mary Beth McCubbin and her students. This event was a huge success. All information and data is being compiled and results will be shared in the near future.

**3) DISCUSSION OF POSITION FOR TOWN ADMINISTRATOR:**

**9) SECOND AND FINAL READING OF "AN ORDINANCE TO ENACT A TOWN ORDINANCE REGULATING SMOKING IN PUBLIC PLACES AND PLACES OF EMPLOYMENT TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC AGAINST THE HARMFUL EFFECTS OF SECONDHAND SMOKE":**

Mayor Hayes asked all to consider referring to this Ordinance as "Sandra's Law" and to establish the effective date of February 1, 2012. Denise Jackson made a motion to accept Ordinance 11-11 for second and final reading. Sandra Gantt seconded. Final vote was 3 to 2. Yes: Mayor Hayes, Sandra Gantt & Denise Jackson. No: Bruce Kalley & Frank Crenshaw.

**10) DISCUSSION OF SUPPORTING THE COUNTY'S REQUEST TO ADOPT "AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT ADVERTISEMENT, POSSESSION, USE, PURCHASE OR DISTRIBUTION OF SUBSTITUTED CATHINONES (COMMONLY CALLED "BATH SALTS"), SYNTHETIC CANNABINOIDS, AND CERTAIN OTHER SYNTHETIC DRUGS; AND MATTERS RELATED THERETO":**

Frank Crenshaw made a motion to pursue a similar Ordinance for the Town of Pendleton. Bruce Kalley seconded. Unanimous.

Sandra Gantt stated it has been her pleasure to serve on the Council for 14 years here in the Town of Pendleton. There were a lot of good days and a lot of bad days, but despite it all, she hopes she has accomplished something good for this town and thanked everyone for the support.
