

Pendleton Town Council

June 13, 2005

After due notice Pendleton Town Council met at Town Hall. Leroy Galloway and Frank Crenshaw were absent.

Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order.

1. **Motion/Vote To Accept The Pendleton Planning Commission Recommendation Pertaining To Rezoning Property Located On South Mechanic Street, TMS #'s 041-00-02-018 and 041-00-02-026 From A-F Zone To PD-MU Zone**

Mayor Burdette asked for a motion to accept the Pendleton Planning Commission's Recommendation Pertaining To Rezoning Property Located On South Mechanic Street, Tax Map No. 041-00-02-018 and 041-00-02-026 From A-F Zone To PD-MU Zone. Sandra Gantt made a motion to accept the Planning Commission's Recommendation. James Allen seconded. Vote unanimous.

2. **First Reading Of The Following Ordinances:**

- A. **An Ordinance To Amend The Town Of Pendleton's Personnel Manual To Clarify Holiday Pay**

Mayor Burdette asked for a motion to accept the first reading of the Ordinance. Sandra Gantt made a motion to accept first reading of the Ordinance. James Allen seconded. Vote unanimous.

- B. **An Ordinance To Amend The Official Zoning Map Of The Town Of Pendleton And To Rezone Property Located On South Mechanic Street, TMS # 'S 041-00-02-018 And 041-00-02-026 From A-F Zone To PD-MU Zone**

- C. **An Ordinance To Amend Ordinance No. 89-04, An Ordinance Establishing Salaries of Mayor And Council And Providing For Payment Of Their Expenses**

3. Second And Final Reading Of The Following Ordinances;

- A. An Ordinance Providing For A Local Hospitality Tax On The Sale Of Prepared Meals And Beverages In Establishments And On Establishments Licensed For On-Premise Consumption Of Alcoholic Beverages, Beer Or Wine In The Town Of Pendleton**

- B. An Ordinance To Adopt The Official Budget Of The Town Of Pendleton For The Fiscal Year July 1, 2005 – June 30, 2006**

- C. An Ordinance Adopting The Final Plat Of Pendleton Station Development In The Town Of Pendleton**

Mayor Burdette asked for a motion to accept the second and final reading of the Ordinance. Sandra Gantt made a motion to accept the second and final reading of the Ordinance. James Allen seconded. Vote unanimous.

4. Motion/Vote To Allow Playground Committee To Cut Trees At Veteran's Park

Mayor Burdette asked for a motion to allow removal of the trees at Veteran's Park. Sandra Gantt made a motion to allow removal of the trees at Veteran's Park. James Allen seconded. Vote unanimous.

5. Motion/Vote To Purchase Christmas Tree For Town Square

There was no discussion regarding the Christmas Tree purchase. This item will be discussed at the July 5, 2005 meeting.

Mayor Burdette adjourned the regular session.

Sandra Gantt made a motion to go out of executive session and enter back into regular session. James Allen seconded. Vote unanimous.
