Minutes

After due notice to the public, Pendleton Town Council met at Pendleton Town Hall in Council Chambers. Mayor and all Council members were present.

Mayor Burdette called the work session to order.

1. Council Updates

Mayor Burdette and Council discussed issues regarding Barrett's Place Playground and the allocation of \$5000.00. They also discussed recognition of Les Flesner and issues regarding the Police Department.

Mayor Burdette adjourned the work session.

Regular Session

Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order.

1. Minutes Of Prior Meetings

The minutes of prior meetings were read. Mayor Burdette asked for a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Frank Crenshaw made the motion. Bruce Kalley seconded. Vote unanimous.

2. Public Comments

There were no public comments.

3. Police Report

Chief Dyar gave his police report for the month of July. He also addressed an issue with Council regarding Sex Offenders living in Pendleton and what steps they take to make sure the public is aware of the circumstances.

4. Barrett's Place Playground Update – PPIM Representative

Jo McConnell presented Council with an update on the fundraising and volunteer requirements. She stated that everything was on schedule for the build date in October. She also advised Council and the public that their Organizational Day is scheduled for August 11, 2005, and invited them to attend. She also requested a meeting with the Town before that date.

5. Approval To Purchase Christmas Tree For Village Green

After a brief discussion regarding the Christmas tree for Village Green, Mayor Burdette asked for a motion to approve the purchase. Sandra Gantt made a motion to approve the purchase of the Christmas tree with the exception that the Town would see if it could be picked up to eliminate the freight charges. Frank Crenshaw seconded. Vote unanimous.

6. Motion/Vote To Allocate Funds For Barrett's Place Playground

After discussions with representatives from Barrett's Place Playground and Council, Mayor Burdette asked for a motion to allocate \$5000.00 to the playground. Sandra Gantt made the motion. Frank Crenshaw seconded. Vote unanimous.

7. Vote To Elect Mayor Pro – Temp

After brief discussion of who had previously served as Mayor Pro – Temp, Mayor Burdette asked for a nomination. Frank Crenshaw nominated Sandra Gantt. Denise Jackson seconded. Vote unanimous. Mayor advised that the term would be held for two (2) years and would end on June 30, 2007.

8. Citizen Recognition Award

Mayor Burdette formally recognized Mr. Les Flesner for his years of service to the community. She presented him with a proclamation stating that August 1 would be recognized as Les Flesner Day. Mayor Burdette asked for a motion to adopt the proclamation. Bruce Kalley made the motion to accept the proclamation. Frank Crenshaw seconded. Vote unanimous.

9. Second And Final Reading Of "An Ordinance To Accept The Final Plat Of Heritage Place Development"

Mayor Burdette stated that she had overlooked item 6. on the agenda, Second and Final Reading of "An Ordinance To Accept The Final Plat of Heritage Place Development". Mayor Burdette asked for a motion to accept final reading.

Frank Crenshaw made a motion to accept final reading. Denise Jackson seconded. Vote unanimous.

A motion was made to go into executive session by Frank Crenshaw. Bruce Kalley seconded. Vote unanimous.

A motion was made by Sandra Gantt to go out of executive session and back into regular session. Denise Jackson seconded. Vote unanimous.

There was no decision made in executive session.

Mayor Burdette adjourned the meeting.
