MINUTES:

After due notice to the press. Town Council met in Council Chambers of the Town Hall. Mayor and all Council were present.

1) MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETINGS:

November 3, 2003 Regular Session 7:30 PM

November 3, 2003 Work Session 6:30 PM

Mayor and Town Council reviewed minutes. After correction of item # 9 "The Grease Trap requirements for the Village Grinder" that being the vote should have read 3 to 2 instead of 4 to 1.

2) PUBLIC COMMENTS:

There were no Public Comments.

3) POLICE REPORT:

Chief Jesse Harris reported that the month of November was a good one for the Police Department. Chief Harris introduced reserve officer Jerry Wild. He also Commended the reserve officers for the donation of their time in the Police Department

4) RECOGNITION OF THE FOLLOWING:

a) Mayor Burdette recognized Billie Allen for her contributions, as a Pendleton Merchant, to the Town of Pendleton. Mayor Burdette presented Ms. Allen with a well-deserved Key to the Town.

b) Mayor Burdette also recognized the Pendleton Lions Club on it's 75th Anniversary, which is December 11, 2003. Mayor Burdette read a Proclamation stating the many contributions the Lions Club gives to the community and what a positive impact they have in the Town of Pendleton. Therefore the Mayor and Town Council Proclaimed December 11, 2003 as Pendleton Lions Club Day. Motion was made by Sandra Gantt to accept this Proclamation. James Allen seconded. Vote was unanimous.

5) FIRST READING OF AND ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE # 2, AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR COUNCIL RULES OF ORDER AND PROCEDURE AT MEETINGS, AND PROCEDURES FOR THE ENACTMENT OR ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS.

Motion was made by Frank Crenshaw to accept the 1st Reading of the above Ordinance. James Allen seconded. Vote was unanimous. A Work Session was scheduled for December 15, 2003, at 6:30pm at Town Hall to work on this Ordinance before second and final reading.

6) SECOND AND FINAL READING OF THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCES:

a) An Ordinance to Repeal an Ordinance for Preserving Peace, Preventing Conflict and Ill-Feeling Between the White and Colored Races in The Town of Pendleton, and Promoting the General Welfare of the Town by Providing, So Far as Practicable For the Use of Separate Blocks, For Residence, Churches, Schools, Hotels, Boarding Houses Restaurants, Places of Public Amusement, Stores and Places of Business of all Kinds. Motion was made by Sandra Gantt to accept the second and final reading of the above Ordinance. Leroy Galloway seconded. Vote was unanimous.

b) AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE TEXT OF THE TOWN OF PENDLETON'S ZONING ORDINANCE:

Section 902.4.3 of this ordinance which states, One sign denoting the architect, engineer, contractor or other service provider when placed at work site and not exceeding thirty-two (32) square feet per face. Sign is to be removed upon completion of work, be added to the Town of Pendleton's Zoning Ordinance.

James Allen made a motion to accept the second and final reading of the above Zoning Ordinance. Frank Crenshaw seconded. Vote was unanimous.

7) RECOMMENDATION FROM THE PENDLETON PLANNING COMMISSION PERTAINING TO A TREE ORDINANCE:

Pendleton Planning recommended that the Pendleton Town Council not add a Tree Ordinance to the Zoning Ordinance. James Allen made a motion not to add the Tree Ordinance. Leroy Galloway seconded. Vote was 3 to 2.

8) NOMINATION OF COUNCIL MEMBER TO SERVE ON THE BOARD OF REGENTS

Leroy Galloway volunteered to serve on this Board.

9) APPOINTMENTS TO THE PENDLETON PLANNING COMMISSION:

Gloria Plotnik's term will be ending December 31, 2003. Sandra Gantt nominated Gloria Plotnik. James Allen nominated Doyle Black. They're being no further nominations. Vote in favor of Ms. Plotnik was 2. Vote in favor of Mr. Black was 3. Nomination went to Doyle Black.

10) APPROVAL AND ALLOCATION OF FUNDING FOR THE FOLLOWING.

a) Microphone for Council Chambers;

A quote of \$250.40 was presented to Council from Crenshaw's TV and Appliance. Motion was made by Leroy Galloway to accept the quote from Crenshaw's TV and Appliance. James Allen seconded. Vote was 4. He being the owner of this business, Frank Crenshaw did not participate in the discussion or voting.

a) Bleachers at Veterans Park.

Mayor and Council would like to check in to possibly having repair work done to the bleachers instead of purchasing new ones.

b) Schedule of Fixed Assets.

The Valuation Advisory Group out of Atlanta gave a quote of \$4,700.00 for inventory and valuation (base fee). Valuation-General fund infrastructure assets (optional) were quoted at \$1800.00. Motion was made by James Allen to accept this proposal. Frank Crenshaw seconded. Vote was unanimous.

11) ADJOURNMENT:

There being no further business the December 1, 2003 meeting of Pendleton Town Council was adjourned.
