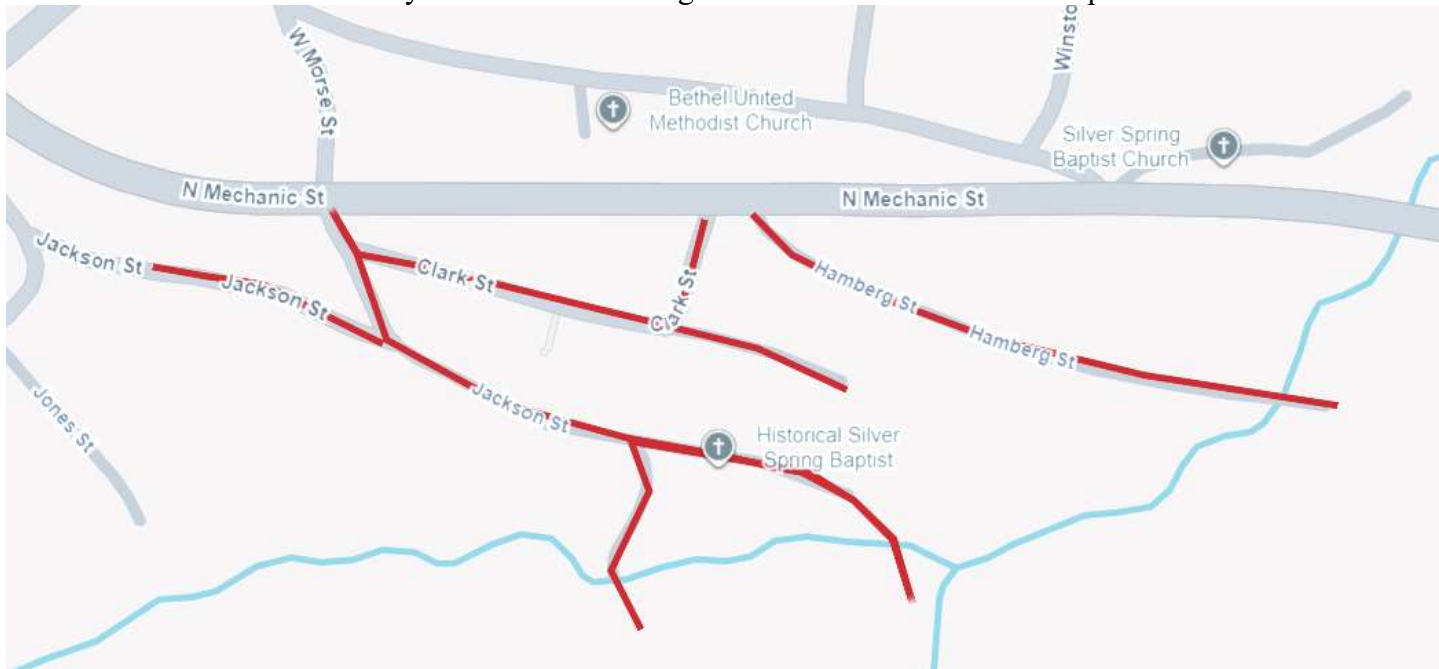


BOIL WATER ADVISORY ISSUED TO CLARK ST., HAMBERG ST., JACKSON ST., AND MORSE ST.

Town of Pendleton Public Works is issuing a **BOIL WATER ADVISORY – UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE effective February 9, 2026 at 1PM.**

The advisory affects the following areas marked in red on the map below:



Roads include: **CLARK ST., HAMBERG ST., JACKSON ST., AND MORSE ST.**

The advisory is given because pressure was lost due to a water main repair. Increased sediment in the lines will be flushed and hydrants may be opened. Please run cold water if you are in the area outlined until the water runs clear.

WATER SHOULD BE VIGOROUSLY BOILED FOR AT LEAST ONE FULL MINUTE PRIOR TO DRINKING OR COOKING AND ANY ICE MADE FROM WATER THAT HAS NOT BEEN BOILED SHOULD NOT BE USED FOR DRINKING PURPOSES.

Customers will be notified through email blast, social media and at www.townofpendleton.org when the problem has been resolved, and there is no longer a need to boil water.
