

BOIL WATER ADVISORY

Hillandale Road and Brickyard Road

Town of Pendleton Public Works is issuing a **BOIL WATER ADVISORY – UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE** effective August 4, 2026 at 12:30PM.

The advisory affects the following areas highlighted below on the map below:



The water main was damaged by a drilling contractor using a shovel. Approximately two feet of the damaged water line was removed and replaced. Due to the loss of system pressure caused by the line break, a Boil Water Advisory was issued for the affected area. The damaged section of the water main was isolated from the remainder of the distribution system to minimize impacts while repairs were completed.

WATER SHOULD BE VIGOROUSLY BOILED FOR AT LEAST ONE FULL MINUTE PRIOR TO DRINKING OR COOKING AND ANY ICE MADE FROM WATER THAT HAS NOT BEEN BOILED SHOULD NOT BE USED FOR DRINKING PURPOSES.

Customers will be notified through email blast, social media and at www.townofpendleton.org when the problem has been resolved, and there is no longer a need to boil water.
